There are now some gloves and balls available for purchase from Brian at the bar. Watch this space - He is also working on stubby holders!

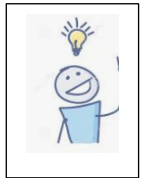
We are about to get new cards printed with the new local rules. They will also only have short or long course on them now with the relevant index.

## Did You Know??

Ambrose: The Ambrose system was named by the secretary-manager of the Victor Harbour Golf Club South Australia in honour of Richard and Mary Ambrose from Michigan, USA, who lived in the area in the 1960s where they had pastoral interests. It was also called the shotgun game. The Ambrose's brought the game from their home club of Spring Valley Country Club in the US where it was called a different name, most like the shotgun game.



It was first played in a National Ambrose Competition at the Liverpool Club in Sydney in March 1974 for a prize of \$5000. One of the winners of the first event was the professional Lindsay Sharp who had a chain of golf shops which he later sold to Ray Drummond
